Next, read in NLT version Break it down over 4 weeks - how can we use this prayer in our prayer lives today? Each week - We will put our prayer into practice in 4 ways! 1. Talk to God 2. Write it out 3. Sing a song 4. Pray Scripture Re-read verses 9-10 in NLT = Celebrate God Birthday Party analogy - what are things you might find at a birthday party to celebrate the birthday person? cake, ice cream, decorations, gifts, friends, candles, etc. How can we celebrate God in our prayer times? thank him (all the things he has done and is going to do), sing to him, pray attributes (amazing, beyond anything I can imagine, compassionate... etc.), thank him for what he given you (family, friends, house, clothes, etc)	Music in bg	Corinne

Verses: Psalm 100:1-5, 1 Chronicles 23:30, Psalm 30:12, 1 Corinthians 15:57, Colossians 4:2, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, Make it a game. See who can find the verse the fastest, have them read it out loud (or help them if they are too young).
