7:16p	Lesson Time - Before lesson: reveal cookies on plate. - Review what we are talking about - breaking down the Lord's Prayer! - Read Lord's Prayer in NLT version - Break it down over 4 weeks - how can we use this prayer in our prayer lives today? - Review last 3 weeks - Celebrate God - thank him for all he has done for us! and Ask him to give you what you need, Ask him for forgiveness. - Each week - We will put our prayer into practice in 4 ways! - 1. Talk to God 2. Write it out 3. Sing a song 4. Pray Scripture Re-read verse 13 in NLT = Just Ask: Part 3 - Ask Him to keep you from doing wrong. - Talk about sins again. List them. - Talk about how difficult it is to keep from doing it again. Once your a Christian are you just perfect and never mess up again? No! - The good news: God will always forgive us when we sin. - The goal: To keep from sinning and messing up over and over again in the same ways. - We can ask God to help us resist temptations that come our way to sin. - Address cookies: talk about how it can be hard to resist the temptation to sin just like it is hard to look at these cookies and not eat them. - Pick a kid to come up and try a cookie. (Cookies have lots of salt in place of the white sugar in them). - After kid spits the cookie out and makes a huge deal about how disgusting it was, talk about how sin can look good and smell good just like those cookies. However, when we give into the temptation to sin, we fell terrible just like that cookie tasted awful. - Examples of temptations: peer-pressure, lying, cheating, stealing. - Pray. Talk To God:

We will put on a slow worship song and just spend some time in prayer. Pastor Corinne will lead the kids in some prayer options: Ask God, ask him to forgive you, ask him to help you keep from sinning again, ask for strength to resist temptation.

K-2nd and 3rd-6th will split for prayer rotation stations! At least one leader with each group.

7:33p **Rotation Stations**

There will be 4 Stations. Each station should last about 7 minutes for each group. K-2nd will go in this order: Station 1, Station 3, Station 2, Fun Station 3rd-6th will go in this order: Station 3, Station 2, Station 1, Fun Station

Station 1: Write it out - Prayer journals - decorate and put together prayer journals to use each week. Pass out prayer journals to those who made them last week and encourage them to continue to add prayers to it and decorate it, they can also get new sheets to add to their prayer journals if they fill some of them up. Have new kids start a new prayer journal.

Station 2: Pray Scripture - Scripture Door Hanger Craft - Give each kid a door hanger and encourage them to pick out a Scripture verse they want to pray in the morning, and a scripture they want to pray at night. Tell them to glue one to each side of the door hanger so they will be reminded to pray their Scripture verses. Encourage them to decorate their door hanger anyway they like and write their name on it.

Station 3: Talk To God - Prayer Sticks - We will have a bucket/jar of popsicle sticks with different prayer topics written on them. Have the kids take turns drawing out a prayer stick and praying for that topic with the group. The goal is to encourage kids to learn to pray out loud in a group. If a kid is struggling feel free to help them and guide them in their prayer.

Fun Station (everyone comes together at the end for this station) - Everyone will receive a cookie from the lesson. We will talk about how they did a great job avoiding the distraction and resisting the temptation earlier.
